



Project dissemination EUFOR

EUFOR is a network of three schools located in Northern Sardinia. Liceo Classico Antonio Gramsci in Olbia, Liceo Scientifico Mossa in Olbia, and Convitto Nazionale Canopoleno in Sassari. EUFOR joined the PEAK project after the first mobility in Cordoba, thus travelled to Burgas (Bulgaria) 3rd-7th April 2017, Leeds (UK) 26th Feb – 2nd March 2018. EUFOR also took part in the final event in Turin (April 2018).

The three schools enrol over 3,000 students all together. Most students are geared towards further education. All classrooms are equipped with high-speed internet and digital equipment.

Teachers and students use smart boards and other digital tools in class in all subjects. English




is studied and most students are encouraged to reach at least a B2 level through Erasmus exchanges and to pursue language certifications through free PON preparation courses.





DISSEMINATION FOLLOWING THE BURGAS (BULGARIA) MOBILITY AT BFU (April 3rd-7th 2017)



During the month of April 2017, following the Burgas (Bulgaria) mobility various dissemination activities were carried out in Liceo

Gramsci in Olbia. The training during the mobility week at BFU focused mainly on the use of the MOODLE e-learning platform.

Once back home participants reported what they did and learned to their colleagues during a special staff meeting, followed by an overview of the main features of the platform.

The school platform (already existing) was thus adapted to facilitate and encourage the use of Moodle for organizational purposes (creating archives for school documents) and for teaching materials (for all the teachers and students of the school). Finally, to ensure full success, students and teachers are, in case of difficulty, constantly supported by our DIGITAL TEAM, by our digital Animator and by the colleagues who took part in the mobility.






DISSEMINATION FOLLOWING THE LEEDS (UK) MOBILITY AT LEEDS-BECKETT UNIVERISTY


(Feb.26th - March 2nd 2018)

The training session in Leeds (UK), which focused on TLA and flipped classroom also had a significant follow up in Liceo Gramsci where formative activities were organized for teachers focusing mainly on:

- 1. Theoretical clarifications on the pedagogical-didactic assumptions linked to flipped teaching
- 2. Groupwork in labs (face to face and online), focused on effective flipped learning unit planning.



Here below are the main points discussed with colleagues during training:

- > microlearning and mobile learning: methodoligical giustifications and assumptions.
- > flipped methodology
 - o problem solving, learning by doing, reflective learning
- > the use of mobiles in teaching and formal meets informal
- flipped structure
 - o anticipation, operative lab phase, metareflection
- > Planning the teaching units
- > flipped classroom using e-learning platforms (Moodle, Edmodo, etc)
- > ICT for productions and sharing of the teaching units:
 - o Google Drive for shared writing
 - o Blendspace for producing digital output during lab activity
 - o Padlet for sharing digital output
 - o EdPuzzle for the use of videos when preparing flipped lessons
 - Zunal for the production of webquest in a flipped context



- o Pinterest to share the units
- > Comparison between digital and analogical flipped lessons
- Competence from planning to lesson and teaching by competences
 - o macrocompetences in citizenship, competency dimensions, criteria e indicators
- Flipped classroom and assessment
 - o docimological and hermeneutical approaches
 - o flipped and embedded assessment
 - o assessment rubrics
