




PEAK Project dissemination at Leeds Beckett University

Leeds Beckett University offer accredited courses in 12 languages, open to all undergraduates at the university. English language courses are also available to undergraduates and academic English courses are available to all international students. In addition, we offer 14 languages as part of the community provision which enrolls over a thousand students each year. All classrooms are equipped with digital equipment and teachers use blackboard and other digital resources to enhance language learning.

Following the training at Bourgas Free University, a workshop was held to introduce the PEAK project to languages staff, especially the eMotion module which was at the core of the training in Bourgas. The workshop was attended by lecturers of a wide range of languages including Arabic, French, Italian, Japanese and Spanish. The aim of the workshop was to give an opportunity to practice using freely available programmes to produce resources for language learning, using the eMotion module. The workshop was received well and participants commented on the usefulness and adaptability of the resources available. Here are some screenshots from the resources produced by tutors.
