PEAK project idea was born in 2013 within ANFIS and was based on the experience made in a previous project funded by the European Commission ("GIFT-Project") to which it was intended to give continuity and development.

The association started to set a project team in Piedmont and Lombardy. At the beginning the project team focused on topics, based on the last year call, around which building a network of European partners with specific areas of expertise, well-designed to the objectives they intended to pursue. The ANFIS team shaped a project proposal based on the findings and the composition of the group of partners and oriented to meet the strategic objectives that EU aims to achieve through the priorities set by the Europe 2020. The project, while getting a high score (91.5 out of 100) failed for a few positions to get in the number of funded projects.

ANFIS, certain of the strength of the proposal, thanks to the project team, proceeded to a careful examination of the assessments of the National Agency and drafted, in the following call, the second project PEAK, which aimed to a greater extent the objectives set by the Europe

2020. The project put at the centre the development of the teaching profession as the strong point for the improvement of educational systems and the consequent strengthening of students 'key competences. The project submitted in the call of Key Action 2 (strategic partnerships) Erasmus Plus, get an estimate of 95.5 points out of 100 that leads, this time, to be granted.
